

getting to Frinton...

The nearest airport to Frinton on Sea is **London Stansted** (STN), served daily from Prague by ČSA (departing 0730 and 1700) and Easyjet (departing 0950 and 1700).

From Stansted Airport, take Coachlink X22 to Colchester Rail Station (departing hourly), and then a train to Frinton (end stop: Walton on Naze).

Other alternatives from Prague are Easyjet (twice daily) or British Airways (once daily) to **London Gatwick**; British Airways (twice daily) or ČSA (three times daily) to **London Heathrow**; or Thomsonfly (most days) to **London Luton**.

From these other London airports, travel into and across London, and catch a train for Frinton from Liverpool Street station.

Stena Line run a ferry from **Hook of Holland to Harwich** (twice daily; journey time 6h 15m).

From Harwich, it's a short 30 minute drive, or 1 hour train journey via Colchester, to Frinton.

Alternatively, Norfolkline run a fast and regular car ferry from **Dunkerque to Dover** (every two hours; journey time 1h 45m).

From Dover, head for London, and join the M25 London Orbital eastbound. Then follow the driving directions below.

Trains run from **London Liverpool Street** to Clacton or Walton on Naze.

For Clacton trains, change at Thorpe le Soken for a connection to Frinton. Walton trains go directly to Frinton without need for changing.

On leaving the station, turn immediately left and head down the short road that connects the car park to Connaught Avenue. At the junction, turn right and head towards the sea. Frinton Free Church is at the end of the main run of shops, on the left-hand-side.

Take the A12 from either London (Junction 28 of the M25) or Ipswich (Junction 55 of the A14) to **Colchester**. Leave the A12 at Junction 29 (signposted Clacton and Harwich) and take the A120.

After about 5 miles on the A120, exit onto the A133 (signposted Clacton). At the roundabout shortly after, take the first exit (signposted Weeley).

At the next roundabout, take the second exit (signposted Frinton) and continue following signs for Frinton.

At Frinton level crossing gates, turn right and cross the railway tracks; head straight down Connaught Avenue, and Frinton Free Church is at the end of the main run of shops, on the left-hand-side.

Parking in Connaught Avenue is limited to two hours only, so we recommend either parking opposite the seafront, or in one of the adjacent roads.
